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1st Call for Papers

The Organizing Committees have the pleasure to invite you to participate in the **Joint 12th IFAC Symposium on Robust Control Design (ROCOND 2027) and 7th IFAC Workshop on Linear Parameter Varying Systems (LPVS 2027)**, to be held in Fortaleza, Ceará, Brazil, July 28-30, 2027. As a joint event, a single common registration will give access to the simultaneous technical activities of both conferences, fostering fruitful discussions and interactions.

Background and scope

The joint conference will present the current state-of-the-art and most recent advances in the theory and industry applications of a large intersection of topics in the field of robust control and linear parameter varying systems. ROCOND has been held since its first edition in 1994 (Rio de Janeiro, Brazil), while LPVS dates from 2015 (Grenoble, France). It will be the third edition of ROCOND and LPVS joint together, following the previous successful meetings held in Florianópolis (2018) and Porto (2025). The event will focus on current challenges and new directions in the development of theoretical and computational tools for versatile practical applications implemented on advanced control systems, including data-driven formulations and control applications in general (cyberphysical, embedded, distributed). The main covered topics are listed below:

Contributions

Initial submissions are expected to be up to eight pages, and final versions up to six pages, in the standard two-column IFAC conference format. Each paper must be covered by one full registration. Accepted regular and invited session papers presented at the Joint Conference will be published in the respective proceedings in IFAC-PapersOnLine.
